



## Aspen: Posting Grades for Secondary Staff 2015-2016



























## Now you can enter comments



For Comment selection, press

Ctrl+L, to look up a Comment
(pop up window appears). Select
the comment and press OK. Only
four (4) comments can be selected
for each student (MP1Com1,
MP1Com2, MP1Com3, and
MP1Com4). The Description of the
comment code will populate to the
Report Card.





You do not need to do anything with the numerical averages. The program will convert them to a letter grade.

You will need to do this for each of your classes. Post each class. If you have to go back and enter grades after you post, you have to repeat this process for that class.
